SUBJECT: Non-traditional Occupations and Pre-Apprenticeship training

REFERENCES:

- California Senate Bill (SB) 293 (Ducheny), Chapter 630, Statutes of 2006
- WIAD06-17 Changes to WIA Requirements – SB293, The Workforce Training Act
- California Unemployment Insurance (UI) Code 1410 (c)(e) and (f)

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to direct the Administrative Entity for the San Luis Obispo County Workforce Investment Board (WIB) and Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Youth Services providers regarding including training in nontraditional occupations for women and girls, and pre-apprenticeship training in youth program activities

BACKGROUND:

The passage of SB 293 (Statutes of 2006, Chapter 630) resulted in changes to the California Unemployment Insurance Code (CUIC) including adding new activities to the required youth council duties. UI Code 14210 (f) states that the Youth Council shall make recommendations to the local board for including training in nontraditional occupations for women and girls and pre-apprenticeship training in youth program activities.

POLICY:

Based on a recommendation from the Youth Council, it is the policy of the San Luis Obispo County WIB that the service providers for youth shall pursue training in nontraditional occupations for women and girls and include pre-apprenticeship training in youth program activities. Further, youth providers shall report to the Youth Council on their progress towards providing training in nontraditional occupations for women and girls as well as their efforts to include pre-apprenticeship training in youth program activities. Additionally, the Administrative Entity shall include language promoting efforts in these areas in all future Request for Proposals (RFP) for WIA Youth services.

ACTION:

The Administrative Entity for the WIB and its service providers shall follow this policy. This policy will remain in effect from the date of issue until such time that a revision is required.
