Industries are represented by a North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code. NAICS codes are available at a two to six digit code level. The two digit code represents the broad industry sector; the third digit represents the industry sub sector; the fourth digit code represents the industry group; the fifth represents the industry, the sixth represents US, Canadian or Mexican National specific. For the purposes of this report, the Industry section is based off of the NAICS two digit level code unless otherwise indicated.

Occupations are represented by a Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) code. SOC codes are a six digit code which begin with a two digit code that represents the major group (major group codes end with 0000); the third digit represents the minor group; the fourth and fifth represent the broad occupation; and the detailed occupation is represented by the sixth digit. The Occupations section represents occupations by the two digit major group unless otherwise specified.
