




For the purposes of this report, the Industry section is based off of the NAICS two digit level code unless otherwise indicated. SOC codes are a six digit code which begin with a two digit code that represents the major group (major group codes end with 0000); the third digit represents the minor group; the fourth and fifth represent the broad occupation; and the detailed occupation is represented by the sixth digit. The Occupations section represents occupations by the two digit major group unless otherwise specified. SLO County ten year projections account for the time period of 2011 to 2021.
